

ACROSS: 1 – go to the other side; 6 – halt; 7 – repeat (2 w.); 9 – repeat as received; 11 – opposite of 27D; 12 – move on wheels;
13 – listen out on frequency; 15 – stop before (3 w.); 16 – opposite of 25A; 20 – carry on; 22 – yield (3 w.); 23 – hasten; 25 – become airborne (2 w.);
28 – change heading; 29 – opposite of 21D; 31 – ... own navigation; 32 – pass information; 33 – verify.

DOWN: 2 – select a code on the transponder; 3 – annul; 4 – ignore; 5 – perform; 8 – confirm the message has been received and understood;
10 – trail behind; 11 – call; 14 – depart; 17 – capture; 18 – ... VFR; 19 – pass on; 20 – for verification; 21 – decrease; 24 – taxi up the runway;
26 – anticipate; 27 – fly down; 30 – wait.
