



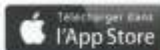

## Practice for the FCL.055 - n°6 Revision crossword

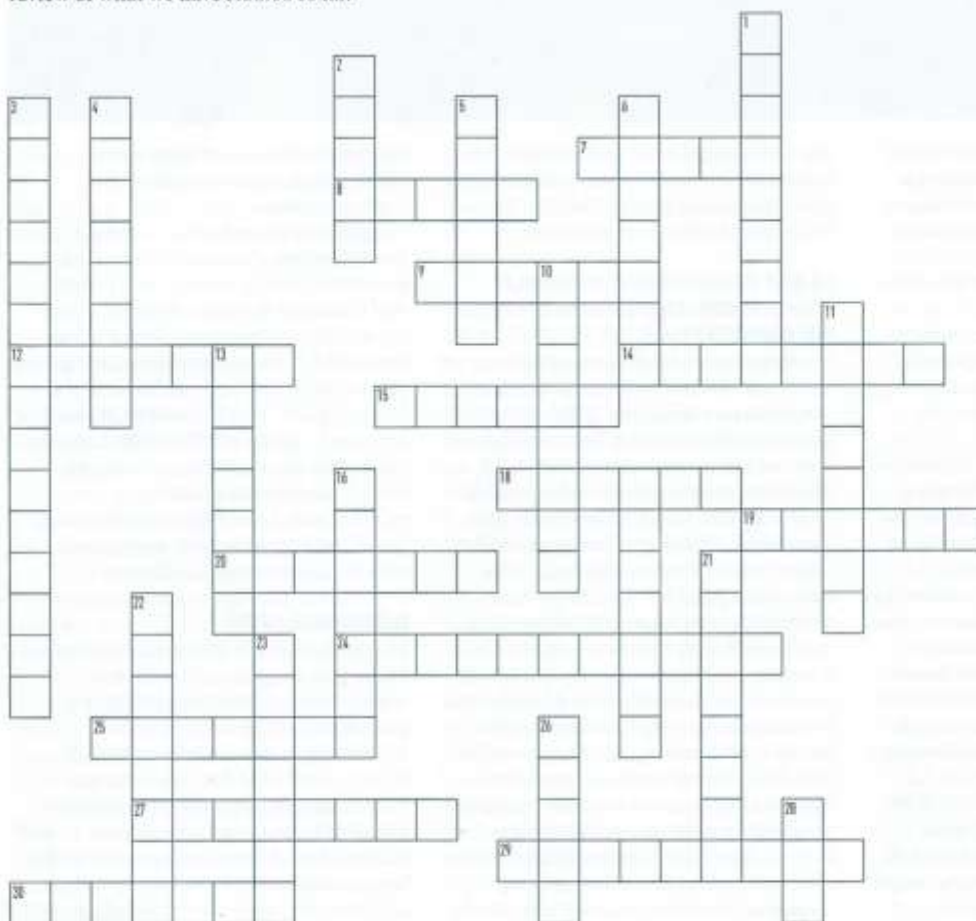
